

The City of Lander Police Department is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Police Officer. This position has an annual pay range from \$38,583 to \$67,917 for Peace Officer Basic and for a professional grade Peace Officer is \$43,594 to \$67,917 depending on qualification. This position is a certified Peace Officer and duties include covering shifts, answering calls for service and patrolling the City of Lander.

Lateral transfers of current Law Enforcement Officers are desired, but not required. Lateral transfers must hold a current Wyoming POST certification or be certified in another state and eligible for challenging Wyoming POST. Starting salaries for lateral transfers are negotiable depending on experience and additional benefits can be considered. The City of Lander offers a very generous benefits package including medical, dental, vision; paid holidays, sick time and vacation; participation in the State Retirement program.

**REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:** High School diploma or GED. Applicants must pass a physical assessment, complete background check, and a psychological exam with the Lander Police Department.
