

Established in 1996, WGIF offers Wyoming public entities daily liquidity as well as a fixed rate, fixed maturity option to invest idle funds which offer competitive interest rates. The primary objectives are to provide safety, liquidity, and yield. Participants have online access to their account information 24 hours a day, seven days a week. WGIF Participants may also take advantage of other investment services provided by its program administrator, PFM Asset Management, a division of U.S. Bancorp Asset Management, Inc. WGIF is owned and operated by the Fund's Participants, ensuring that the Fund remains focused on the needs of Wyoming's public entities. WGIF's Board of Trustees is elected by Participants and is made up of Wyoming public officials. 




